M. PHIL. ADMISSION NOTIFICATION 2022-23

Applications are invited for the academic year 2022-23, in the prescribed format from Karnataka Domicile* candidates for the following two year full-time M.Phil. courses in Clinical Psychology (RCI approved) and Psychiatric Social Work, (mentioned under Allied Health Science- Behavioral Health Science Professional, ISCD code 2635) at DIMHANS Dharwad, affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Bangalore. The said courses are conducted under the guidance of NIMHANS.

Eligibility Criteria:**

1. For M. Phil in Clinical Psychology:

- 2 years Master's Degree in Clinical Psychology / Counseling Psychology / Applied Psychology/ Psychology (Applicants should have pursued and awarded qualification from an Institution/University recognized by UGC)
- The candidates should have secured not less than 55% marks in aggregate in their PG course. For SC/ST candidates minimum marks required is 50% in aggregate.

2. For M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work:

- 2 years Master's Degree in Social Work (Applicants should have pursued and awarded qualification from an Institution/University recognized by UGC)
- The candidates should have secured not less than 55% marks in aggregate in their PG course. For SC/ST candidates minimum marks required is 50% in aggregate.

Number of seats:

Five seats are in M.Phil. Clinical Psychology and five seats in M.Phil. Psychiatric Social Work. Seats will be filled as per Karnataka State Government reservation roster for higher education in each course. Reservation for Hyderabad Karnataka candidates is also applicable. However if no eligible candidates are available under any applicable reserved seats, they shall be filled by the eligible candidates based on remaining roster and merit.

Procedure of application form submission:

Link for registration and application form is available on <https://dimhans.karnataka.gov.in>. The candidate has to click on the link to open the registration form. Upon successful registration, a registration number and login credentials will be sent to the registered email ID. Candidate can open the application form using the same and fill it step by step. Candidates need to mention if they want to claim any reservations that are applicable in higher education. Upon the final submission of the application, candidate can take a print of the application form. For any further correspondence, candidate will have to use their registration number. After the scrutiny of documents, the approval status will be sent to candidate's registered email ID, which may take 4-6 working days. Regularly check your inbox/spam folder. Candidates whose

application has been approved will be able to download their hall tickets using the same login credentials. A print of the hall ticket needs to be produced during entrance examination.

Documents to be uploaded while filling the application form:

1. A color passport size photograph (File size:10-20 KB)
2. A scan of signature (File size:10-20 KB)
3. PG Marks cards and degree certificate (Provisional degree certificate is also acceptable)
4. Domicile certificate issued by Tehsildar
5. Reservation certificates if applicable (H K, Caste and income certificates)
6. Transaction receipt of payment

NOTE: All claims made in the application must be supported with documentary proof in original along with a set of photocopies at the time of interview/admission.

Payment details:

Application fee (non-refundable) is Rs.1000/- for general & OBC candidates and Rs.500/- for SC/ST candidates. Payment can be done through any online mode. No other offline method of payment is accepted.

Entrance Test:

Entrance Test consists of 100 multiple choice, objective type questions. Each question carries one mark with negative marking of 0.25 marks for wrong answers. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of Entrance Test shall be 90 minutes.

Selection Process:

The applicants should appear for the Entrance Test. Candidates should clear the written entrance test with minimum of 50% marks to become eligible for counselling interview. For SC ST candidates minimum marks is 45%. After the entrance test, a list of candidates qualified for interview/ counselling in order of merit and reservation will be announced. The selection is entirely based on marks obtained in entrance examination and reservation roster.

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in entrance test, merit will be considered based on the marks in their qualifying PG exam. Seat allotment will be done through counselling/interview.

** To claim that candidates are domiciles of Karnataka, he/she should produce a Domicile certificate from the Tehsildar.*

***Candidates who have appeared for the qualifying examination and are awaiting results may also apply. However, such candidates will be eligible to appear for the interview/ admission only if they produce the proof of having passed the qualifying examination in writing during admission counseling.*

Other instructions

- In case, grades are awarded in lieu of marks in the qualifying examination, candidates have to produce a certificate from the University clearly stating the range of marks into which each of the grades fit.
- Applicants who have been awarded external fellowship from various governmental Agencies like UGC also can apply.
- Candidates called for Entrance Test / Interview/ Admission will have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay. No TA/DA will be paid by DIMHANS.
- Candidates appearing for Entrance test shall carry their valid ID proof (Adhar card/ passbook/voter ID/ college ID card etc.) and hall ticket.
